With the retirement of the Ford Crown Victoria by Ford, a new police vehicle had to be selected for the Town of Ramapo Police Department. Extensive research including a trip to the NYS Fairgrounds in Syracuse, NY to test replacement vehicles was done.

The 2014 Ford Police Interceptor Utility vehicle was chosen by the Town of Ramapo Police Department. Among some of its features:



- V-6 300 hp Engine
- Police Tuned Suspension
- 75- Mph Rear-Crash Test Rated
- All Wheel Drive
- Heavy Duty Tires and Wheels
- Mobile Video Camera's
- Computer Aided Dispatch
- Encrypted Police Radio's

The markings of the vehicle were designed with input from the officers of the Town of Ramapo Police Department. Marked as well as unmarked Police Interceptors Utility vehicles are now patrolling the neighborhoods of the Town of Ramapo. Eventually the Town of Ramapo Police Department expects to replace the majority of its patrol fleet with this vehicle.
