Subject: Burglary Arrests

The following individuals have been arrested in conjunction with a burglary that occurred at 10 Mountain Road in Pomona on April 7th 2008.

They are identified as follows:

1. Angela G. Lake, DOB 12/22/89 of 451 Call Hollow Road in Stony Point
2. Christopher Rodriguez, DOB 7/2/89 of 3 Helen Court in Hillcrest

There first contact was with RPD detectives after a traffic stop conducted on 4/8/08. This stop led to further investigation and surveillance in numerous locations. Later in the day on 4/8/08 they were located by a RPD detectives walking in a Poughkeepsie, NY neighborhood. They were stopped and arrested. At that time they were in possession of property that appeared stolen.

A number of searches have been conducted at various locations including the Town of Haverstraw and City of Middletown, NY.

A number of laptops have been recovered along with many other items that appear to be stolen.

RPD detectives are working to identify the owners of the laptops and other property. Some of the property recovered has been identified as having been recently stolen from other burglaries in the Town of Ramapo. A laptop that was recovered was stolen from RCC.

We received assistance from the Town of Haverstraw PD, the Town of Stony Point PD, the Town and City of Poughkeepsie PD, the Rockland County Intelligence Unit and Rockland County BCI.

They were arraigned in the Town of Ramapo Justice Court and remanded to the Rockland County Jail on \$50,000 bail.
