Do's

Place bins curbside the night before collection.

Remove recycling bins from curb immediately after collection.

Rinse containers to remove excess foods. Place glass, plastic, tin, aluminum, bi-metal jars and bottles in recycling bins.

Place newspapers and inserts, junk mail and magazines in recycling bin.

Flatten corrugated cardboard. Tie with cord or place in recycling bin.

Use a mulching lawn mower so that there is no need to bag grass clippings.

Bring car batteries and motor oil to a service station.

Tire disposal stickers are available for \$3 apiece from the Town Clerk's office at 845-357-5100. Attach a sticker to each tire and place at the curb on your regularly scheduled recycling day.

Collect leaves in bio-degradable paper bags and place at the curb. Up to 25 leaf bags per visit are available **FREE** at the Department of Public Works, located at 18 Pioneer Ave, Tallman.

Don'ts

Don't put recycling bins curbside on a non-recycling day.

Don't leave empty bins at the curb later than 8:00 p.m. on the day of collection.

Don't place non-recyclables in the recycling bins.

Don't put broken glass, light bulbs, china or porcelain in recycling bins.

Don't put newspapers or magazines in paper or plastic bags.

Don't put cardboard boxes outside for pickup if they're not broken down. Flatten and secure them first.

Don't put leaves in plastic bags.

DON'T DUMP USED MOTOR OIL, ANTI-FREEZE IN SEWERS OR ON THE GROUND SO AS NOT TO CONTAMINATE OUR DRINKING WATER.

Don't put plastic bags in recycling bins.
