

The measurable goal was to sponsor or facilitate at least one class that would educate the public and/or contractors with respect to a particular pollutant. Through our contact with Cornell Cooperative Extension, twelve (12) classes were held on the County Fertilizer Law and twelve (12) radio shows were broadcast on WRCR on a variety of stormwater related topics.

Twenty-five (25) people from Ramapo attended the classes regarding the Fertilizer Law with 115 attending total. Twelve (12) half hour radio shows were broadcast over local airways. Many shows received telephone calls pertaining to the topics of discussion.

We did not think that our practice of going door to door to educate residents about the storm drain markings and the importance of clean stormwater was going to occur because of the Covid-19. As it turns out the pandemic was even worse than anticipated. We did indicate however we would come up with an alternative.

There were no observations with respect to the door to door education because it did not occur. As the alternative, the Town Supervisor sent out flyers to each of our residences (7142 of them) to alert them of an upcoming Spring Cleanup Event. These flyers mentioned how to dispose of household hazardous wastes among other things. It seems to have been well received since we did not have too many attempts of residents leaving these items curbside.

Since the beginning of the original 5 year permit period, the Town of Ramapo has been flushing our sanitary trouble areas to prevent sewer blockages and resulting sewer discharges. We have reached our goal of flushing at least 5 miles in 16 of the past 17 years. This past reporting year we flushed 9.3 miles which is one of our highest figures since the program began.

This activity has been effective in pro-actively removing grease and paper buildup on the inner walls of our sewer lines. We see this working every day by virtue of the reduction of call outs we receive reporting blockages both during and after work hours.

Since the catchbasins immediately upstream from Lake Suzanne in the Town's jurisdiction are almost complete, we will install future grate plates on other catchbasins that lead to other tributaries of the Pascack Brook.

This action increases the effectiveness of our storm drain system by collecting and transporting stormwater runoff and removes both sediment and debris from downstream water bodies. We cleaned out 254 catchbasins in this past reporting period.
