Academy Award Winning Documentary Opens Ramapo Fall Film Festival October 22nd

*“Twenty Feet From Stardom” features Ramapo resident
Darlene Love member of the Rock & Roll Hall of Fame*

Suffern, NY – The 15th Annual Ramapo Film Festival begins on October 22nd with the screening of the Academy Award Winning Documentary *“Twenty Feet From Stardom”*. It is the untold story of the background singers behind some of the greatest musical legends of the 20th Century. The film is a tribute to the unsung voices who helped shape popular music and a reflection of their conflicts, sacrifices and rewards.

One of the singers featured in the film is Rockland County resident Darlene Love, who gained fame in the 1960’s for the song “He’s A Rebel” the number one single in 1962. In 2010 she was chosen for induction into the Rock & Roll Hall of Fame. Darlene Love has performed with numerous music legends including Sam Cooke, Dionne Warwick, Bill Medley, the Beach Boys, Elvis Presley, Tom Jones, Sonny & Cher.
